IDEA WAS BORN

- iamtheCODE is the brainchild of Senegalese Businesswoman Lady Marième Jamme. She founded the Charity to get marginalised girls to learn how to code and gain digital skills.
- In **Sept 2016**- Recognised by the UN High-level Panel of Economic Empowerment.
- In **November 2016**, the First Hackathon was launched in Senegal with UN Women with 100 girls.
- Launch in Uganda, Nepal and Afghanistan.

In 2017, iamthecode began building partnerships with the Argentine and Chinese Government, taking on projects from Businesses like Unilever and the Liverpool City Council.



LAUNCH OF IAMTHECODE REFUGEE CAMPS

- iamtheCODE launches coding clubs in a Refugee camp with 250 girls and organised various boot camps and Day of the Girls events in the UK and in Kenya.
- iamtheCODE launches the first hackathon and coding clubs with Unilever in Kingston with 100 girls.
